

Yacht Marigo Itinerary and Contact Information 1968 – 1971

(Compiled by Ted Hine – April 2003)

The following copies, distributed by Kirt and Mary Hine to relatives and friends, give a generally idea of Yacht Marigo's schedule and how to stay in contact for the 3 sailing seasons from the fall of 1968 to the spring of 1971. The last page is a list of recommended items for friends to bring if they were planning on visiting aboard for a part of the voyage.

Hello again:

We're heading YACHT MARIGO south October 15th, 1968, aiming point Grenada, the southern tip of the West Indies.

The plan is:

New York to Jupiter, Florida - October 15th - November 5

Thereafter -- no mail will reach us. Mail sent to us at our Garrison address will be opened by the Fishkill National Bank, and the messages relayed to us during our weekly or bi-monthly contacts with them.

TELEPHONE

During our coastwise run to Florida a call for YACHT MARIGO through all coastwise "Marine Operators", New York through Miami should reach us. Also, we hope our new 3000 mile "Hi-Seas" radio will be effective along the coast although it is designed for "beam into the ocean type work". So, also try the Telephone Company station W00, New York, Hi-Seas station.

After December 1st our radio contact is The Florida A.T.&T. Co., "Hi-Seas" station W.O.M., and we hope to be able to reach them, depending on atmospheric conditions, and ask if there is any traffic for MARIGO almost daily, all the way to Grenada. MIAMI

Returning, our plans are Jupiter, Florida (The Jib Club) late April or early May. Pending completion of our new home there, we will then let you know our new permanent address.

(2) By radio telephone as follows:

Place a call to Yacht Marigo by asking your local operator for Miami Marine Operator.

When you reach Miami Marine Operator, say "I wish to make a Hi Seas call to Yacht Marigo (WX 9479) - (pronounced Whiskey X-Ray 9479) to Mr. or Mrs. Hine.

We activate our radio once a day to ask Hi Seas if we have any traffic, usually after 11:00 A.M. When we are advised of traffic, we ask the operator to try to complete the call.

Winter Cruise - 11/15/70 to 4/31/71 - E.K. Hine
and M. P. Hine aboard the Yacht Marigo.

Proposed Itinerary to Galapagos Islands - Nov. 15, 1970 to Jan. 18, 1971

Jupiter - Cozumel	Nov. 15 - 29 - 2 weeks Stopping at Ft. Lauderdale, Ocean Reef, Key West and Dry Tortugas, then a 3 day ocean crossing to Cozumel, an island off the coast of the Yucatan Peninsula, Mexico.
Cozumel - Belize	Nov. 29 - Dec. 7th. 10 days. Overnight stops until we reach Belize, British Honduras.
Belize - Roatan	Dec. 9 - 18th. 9 days. More day sails until we reach the island of Roatan, Honduras.
Roatan - San Andres	Dec. 18 - Dec. 30th. 12 days More day sailing to the island of San Andres, Colombia.
San Andres to Cristobal Panama.	Jan 1 - 3. A 3 day ocean crossing.
Cristobal - Balboa, Canal Zone	Jan 3 - 10th. 7 days. Allowance for going through the Canal and re provisioning.
Balboa to Galapagos	Jan. 10 - 18th. An 830 mile ocean crossing.
Galapagos	Jan. 18 - Feb. 12 more or less.
Back to Balboa	Feb. 12 - 20th.

Our return trip is as yet unscheduled, since we need to be more familiar with the territory before making a decision. The above dates are also necessarily subject to change depending on unpredictable conditions.

Return Trip Tickets - Most Countries want to be sure that you do not plan to stay indefinitely. If you board Marigo in one place, and have a departure ticket from another, there would be no problem.

Immunization: - Small pox Vaccination Certificates are usually required for return to U.S. as well as entry into other Countries.
A Tetanus Shot is advisable, but not required.

Things you will Need

1. A duffle, or collapsible bag, for your clothing.
(Suitcases present a stowage problem).
2. Chap stick in case the Sun dries your lips.
3. Sun Tan Lotion - the non-staining, non-greasy type.
Solarcaine (or other) in case treatment for burn is necessary.
Solex - one tube - protects your face from all injurious rays.

4. Seasick Remedy - An oz. of prevention is worth a lb. of cure.
Bring Marezine, Bonine, Dramamine, or other.
5. Sun Glasses.

Clothing - Minimum Amount - Stowage a problem- No Laundry

1. A hat or cap for protection from the sun.
2. Lightweight long sleeves and pants for protection from the sun.
3. Socks to protect the tops of your feet in case of burn or swelling.
4. A waterproof jacket, and I do mean waterproof, for protection from salt spray, or tropical downpours.
5. Swim trunks, bikinis, or suits. These really cut down on the soiled clothes situation. Also it is often very hot.
6. Dinner Ashore: Men - lightweight jacket and pants, or shorts.
Shorts allowable in most places.
Ladies - packable, non-crushable type shift or dress, or separates.
7. For exploring ashore - a skirt or pants shift. Shorts and pants are never worn by Native ladies, but in Cozumel anything goes.
8. Boat shoes, or sneakers, No leather soles permitted on Marigo.
and/or toe splitters.
9. A sweater, in case it is cool, especially in the Pacific and at Galapagos. In fact it is sometimes well to have one anywhere.
