
Earl Seward Hulburd Funeral Service BookMarch 27, 1950

A record of Bud Hulburd's funeral service at the Sheppard Funeral Home in St. Louis, MO on March 27, 1950 was kept and stored for years by his sister Betty Hulburd-Hine-Alderson.

Only the pages of the funeral service book which contained entries appear below. The lines through the Friends Who Called and the Flowers entries indicate that Betty likely responded to these persons with a thank-you note. The Relatives Attending page contained no entries but Betty was clearly in there as evidenced by her handwriting in the book as, I presume. was Bud's father, Dutch Hulburd. I do not know whether Bud's other living blood relatives, sister Harriet and great uncle Ernie Hulburd, attended.
